# THE MESSENGER

[From Our Pastor: A Vision for Mission in 2025]

I want to share a vision for the road ahead—a path rooted in God's call to mission. Our God is always on the move, drawing us into His work of redemption and inviting us to join Him in transforming the world with His love. This is our calling. God gathers us as His people—not to isolate us from the world but to prepare us to go back into it, carrying His light and truth (John 17:15-18).

Our mission begins with God. He calls us out of the noise and distractions of this world, gathers us into His family, and empowers us with His Spirit. Together, as a community of faith, we are equipped to proclaim His Word and to serve those around us. Then, God sends us back into the world—not alone, but as part of what Michael Yaconelli calls "a conspiracy of grace." This grace-filled conspiracy is our charge: together we love the rejected, heal the broken, and reflect God's glory in every corner of our lives.

Each of us is uniquely crafted by God (Psalm 139:13). We serve one God, but we serve Him in beautifully diverse ways, using the unique gifts He has given us. Our challenge in 2025 is to embrace our differences and unite as one body, serving together as a family.

This year, let's focus on restoring brokenness by being examples of God's love in everything we do – in our speech, speaking truth and encouragement; in our work, doing everything for the Lord; in our relationships, loving and forgiving one another deeply; and in our communities, looking for the lonely, hurting, and marginalized, inviting them into God's family.

Practical steps we can take include partnering with local organizations, hosting events that meet the needs of our neighbors, and engaging in intentional discipleship that empowers others to live out the gospel.

The Great Commission is our rallying cry (Matthew 28:19-20). We don't just want to announce Christ; we want to *illustrate* His kingdom through concrete, real acts of love and service. By doing so, we compel others to glorify God.

I invite you to not only dream with me about what this mission could look, but intentionally work to make our vision a reality in our church and community. How can we exercise our gifts to be the hands and feet of Christ? How can we foster unity in our diversity and love in our service? Let's pray together, plan together, and walk boldly in 2025 as ambassadors of God's grace.
