[From Our Pastor: Take Up Your Cross and Follow in Jesus' Footsteps]

As we enter the season of Lent, we follow in the footsteps of Jesus: from the wilderness to the cross, from suffering to glory. We walk with Him, learning what it means to take up our own cross and follow Him (Luke 9:23).

The cross stands at the center of our faith, reminding us of both the cost of our sin and the depth of God's love. Saint Augustine once said, "God had one Son on earth without sin, but never one without suffering." Jesus walked the road of suffering so that we might walk the road of salvation. Doing so comes with a heavy responsibility. Jesus tells us, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me" (Luke 9:23).

What does it mean to carry our cross? It means embracing sacrifice, humility, and love, walking as Christ walked and allowing His suffering to shape our faith. Here are some concrete ways we can take up our cross this season.

Carrying our cross means putting others first. Saint Therese of Lisieux reminds us: "A word or a smile is often enough to put fresh life in a despondent soul." It also means being faithful in prayer, even when it feels dry or difficult. Saint John Chrysostom taught, "Prayer is the light of the soul." Finally, it means humbling ourselves before God and seeking reconciliation with others, especially those who are being harassed and mistreated by society. Saint Augustine said, "God has promised forgiveness to your repentance, but He has not promised tomorrow to your procrastination." Carrying the cross is not about misery; it is about knowing that every sacrifice brings us closer to Christ.

This Lent, consider reading through the Gospel accounts of Jesus' journey to the cross. Let His words and actions shape your heart and mind and encourage you as you walk in His footsteps. And may the promise of Easter morning fill your heart with the assurance that death is defeated, and life in Christ is yours forever.




